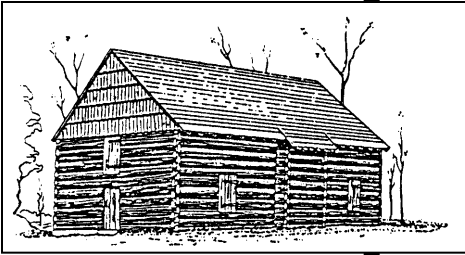

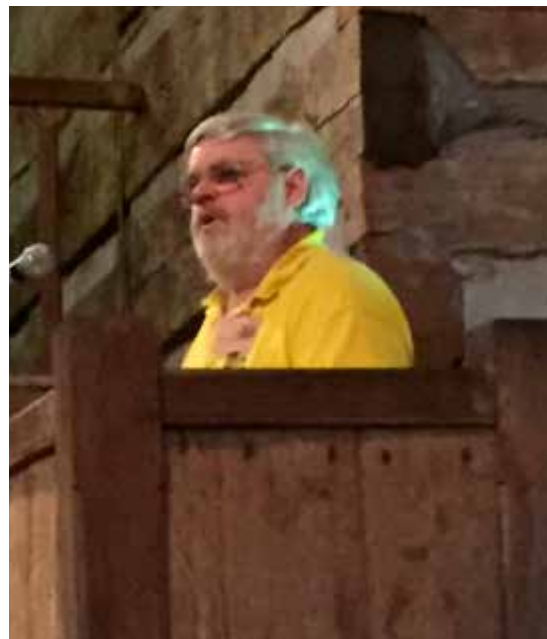

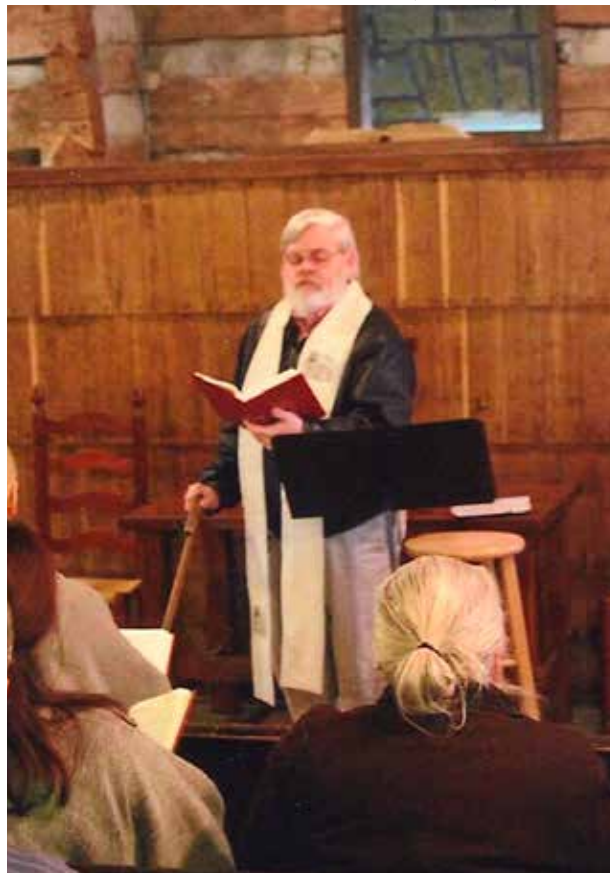

## Closing Service Celebrates Aylette Raines

The October 31 End of Season Closing Worship Service saw about 25 gather on a cool fall day to celebrate the ministry of Cane Ridge. Aylette Raines, while not a settled pastor at Cane Ridge did speak on many occasions in the Meeting House while he served churches in the surrounding communities, including Paris, Millersburg, Winchester, and North Middletown. Raines was an early convert to the Stone-Campbell Churches and a popular preacher and teacher. He was known for strong opinions, particularly in favor of Temperance and in opposition to those in the church who would engage in the "Liquor Traffic. Although reluctant to sanction organized choirs and musical performance in churches he allowed some young members to provide special music in First Christian Church, Paris, KY.
